Personal Fall Protection Equipment Users Training Course

Course Aim

To show learners how to select, use and fit appropriate fall protection equipment, to provide a basic overview of the Work at Height Regulations, general safety considerations relating to work at height and to provide familiarisation with site specific fall protection equipment and conditions.

Learning Outcomes

- Describe duties and responsibilities of employers and employees when conducting work at height.
- Explain the hierarchy of control for work at height.
- Carry out a pre-use check of fall protection equipment (harness and lanyard)
- Distinguish between fall arrest and fall restraint systems and describe when each system is appropriate.
- Fit a harness correctly and explain the importance of properly fitting PFPE.
- Identify fall protection kit from its label.
- Explain procedures and systems for inspection and examination of fall protection equipment.

Scope

A certificate of training will be issued to successful delegates on completion of the course. The certificate is valid for 2 years. Instructor: delegate ratio 1:6
